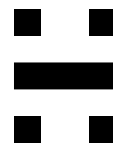
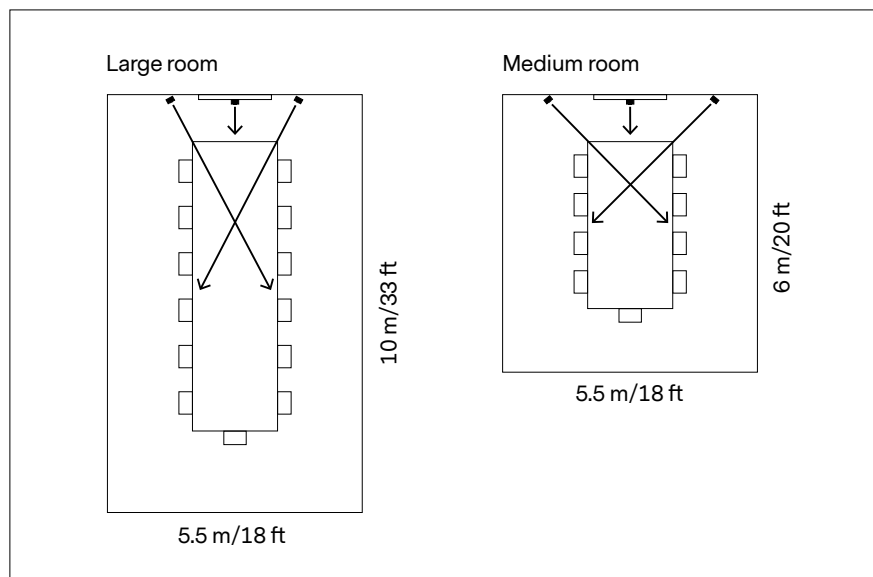

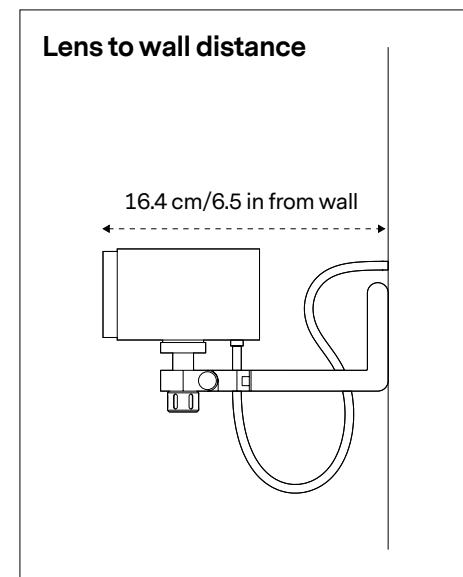


## Recommended room sizes



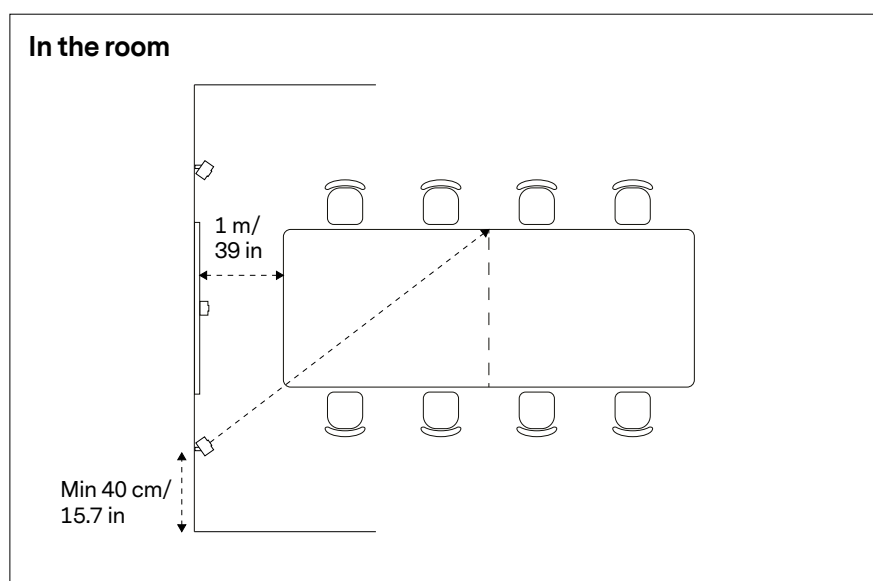
Huddly Crew is all about being flexible and adjusting to your space's needs. Be sure to adapt these guidelines to suit your unique setting.

## Accessibility

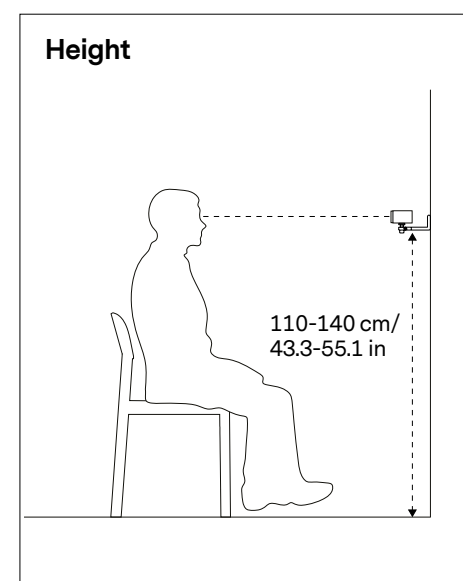


The total distance between the back wall and the front of the camera is 16.4 cm/6.5 inches.

## Camera placement

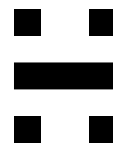


Side cameras: Keep a minimum of 40 cm/15.7 inches distance from side wall to bracket center. Angle them diagonally towards the table's center. Center camera: Place it at least 1 m away from the table.

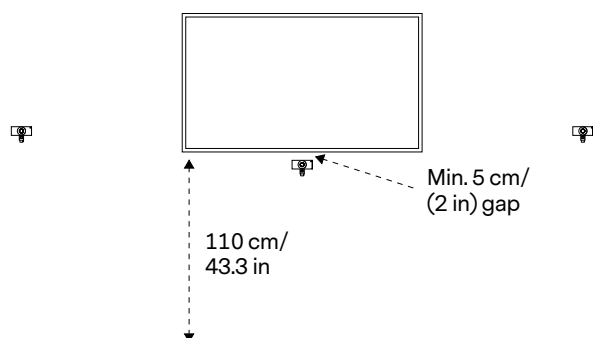


Place cameras at eye level to enable eye contact between remote and in-room participants.

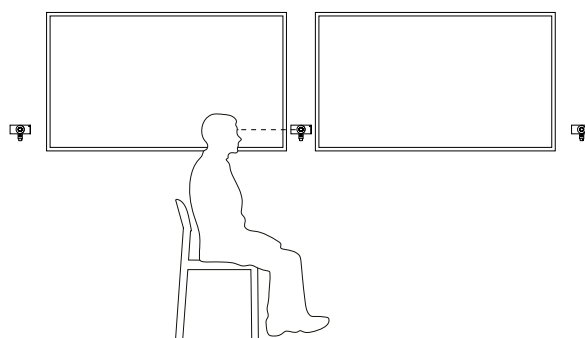


## Single-screen positioning



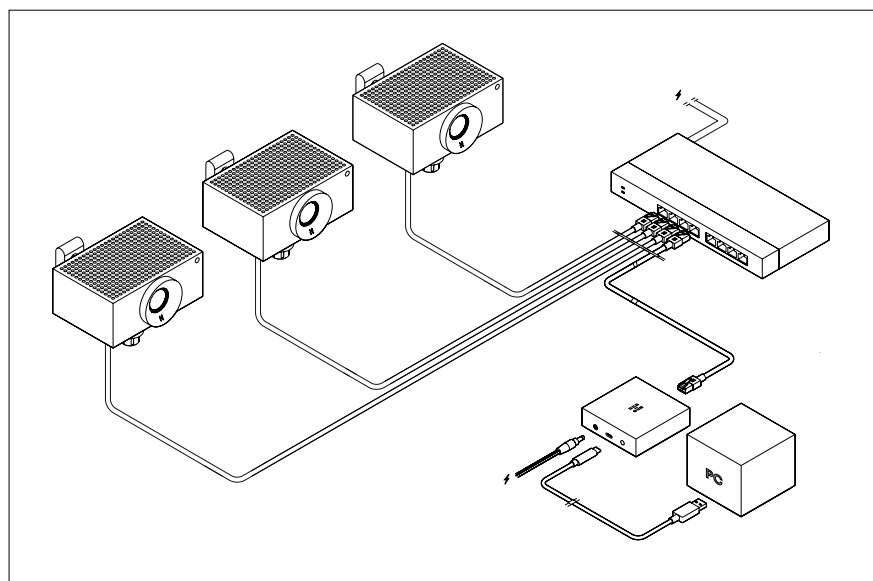
Position the side cameras at an appropriate distance from the screen to capture all participants. For the center camera, maintain a minimum 5 cm/2-inch gap from the screen.
